

# YEAR 9 – 10 UNIFORM GIRLS

## PLEASE NOTE:

- Papakura High School encourages pride in appearance and personal grooming.
- The correct school uniform should be worn at ALL times when students are travelling to and from school, as well as throughout the school day.
- All uniform items should be neat, tidy and smart and clearly named.
- Shoes should be clean and polished. Boots and sports shoes are NOT acceptable.
- Jewellery is restricted to one small stud earring for each ear and one watch.
- No facial piercing permitted. Bars, studs, rings and keepers are not permitted to be worn in body piercing while students are at school, travelling to and from school, or at official school functions. First aid plasters are NOT permitted to cover bars, studs, rings or keepers being worn in body piercing.
- No writing or graffiti on bags, books or items of clothing.
- No make-up.
- No unusual hair colours, styles or ornaments.

### Year 9 – 10

Regulation straight skirt in green tartan worn to knee length.

Regulation white school blouse with school logo.

Regulation bottle green school jacket.

Regulation bottle green school jersey with logo.

### Shoes

Plain black leather shoes, either lace-up or with a strap over the top of the foot with black ankle socks. Black pantyhose may be worn in Terms 2 & 3.

### Optional

Scarf - plain black or bottle green.

Hat – regulation.
